As noted in the previous newsletter, Golden Triangle Storage (GTS) received a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) on July 23, 2024, authorizing GTS to expand its existing natural gas storage facility in Jefferson County through construction of the Golden Triangle Storage Expansion Project (Expansion Project). This newsletter will update you on the status of construction and summarize certain pertinent information that has been provided to FERC throughout the construction reporting process.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE


GTS began construction of the Expansion Project in October 2024. Both caverns are anticipated to be operational by third quarter 2027.



CONSTRUCTION STATUS

Following site prep, including civil survey and mobilization of the drilling rig, GTS began drilling Cavern 3, and installed casing for Cavern 3. Once the casing was installed, GTS started solution mining Cavern 3, and commenced drilling operations on Cavern 4. Additionally, GTS's contractors installed some piping and restored disturbed areas within the service corridor. As of this newsletter, GTS's contractors continue solution mining Cavern 3 and are installing casing in Cavern 4. The contractors have also begun work on the new compressor building, and initial work at the new brine disposal well.

ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE

The on-site environmental inspector continues to actively monitor environmental compliance during construction. All GTS construction personnel are required to maintain strict compliance with permit conditions relating to the protection of the environment. In the event a non-compliant action is observed, the environmental inspector has the authority to stop work until the compliance matter is resolved. Non-compliances are reported to the FERC and reported in GTS's monthly reporting.
